Oregon GO Grants

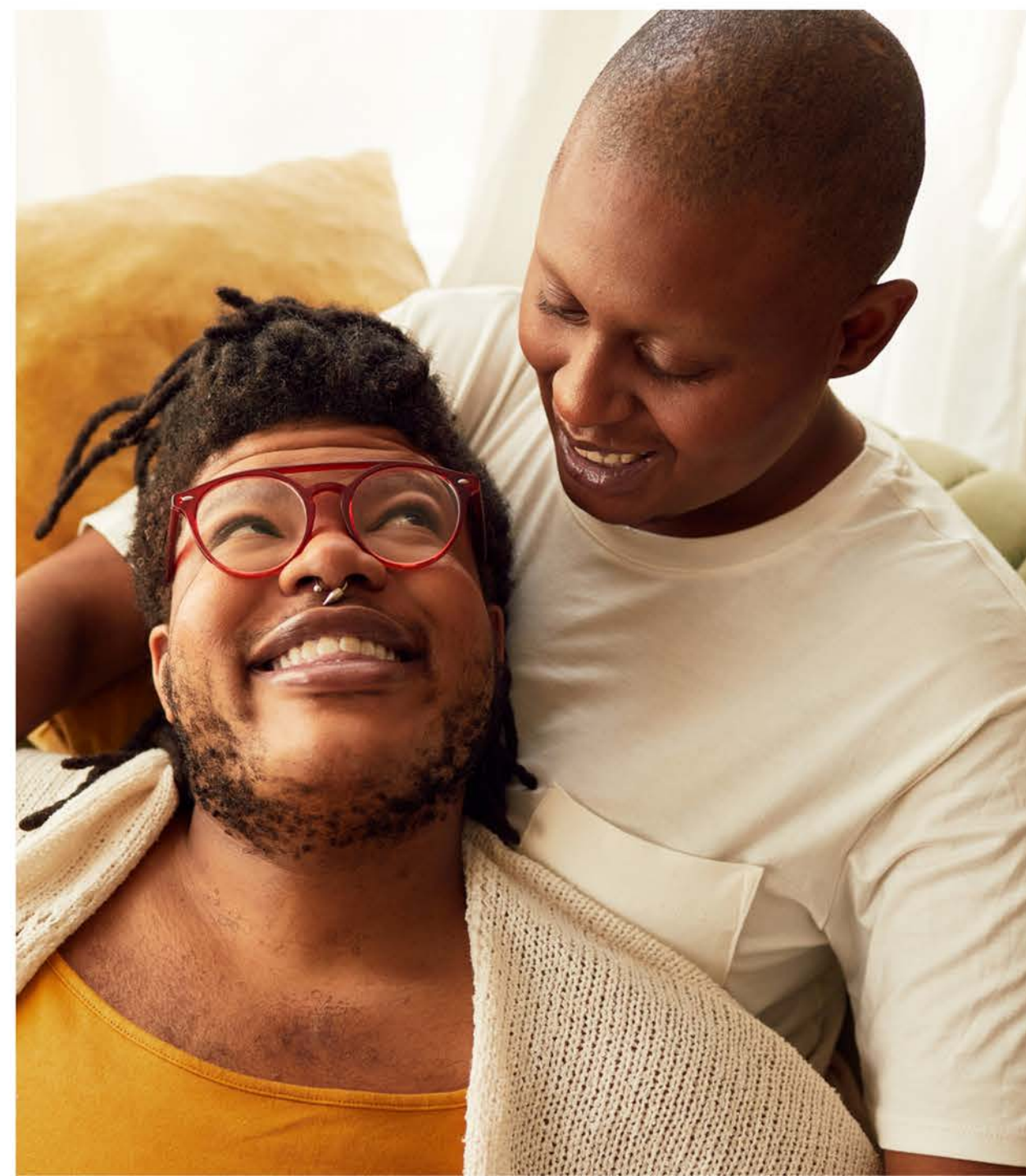
\$10,000 for 25 qualifying organizations serving Oregon residents.

For those serving two-spirit, trans, gender non-conforming, and/or intersex folks and their loved ones.



What is a GO Grant?

- Unrestricted general operating fund
- Applicants are 501c3's, organizations with fiscal sponsors, and Tribal Nations
- Apply online in 10 minutes or less
- Applications are first-come, first-serve
- Instantly know if you meet the grant eligibility criteria



Who should apply?

- **Serving** two-spirit, trans, gender non-conforming, and/or intersex folks and their loved ones in Oregon
- **Executive Team, Board or Leadership has representation from the following:**
 - Black and/or indigenous and...
 - Two-spirit, trans, gender non-conforming, and/or intersex
- **Operating Budget** Under \$2 million
